PUBLIC TRADE NOTICE No. 05/2026

Sub: Customs- Hazardous cargo declaration and identification in Bill of Entry – Regarding.

विषय: सीमा शुल्क - प्रवेश बिल में खतरनाक माल की घोषणा और पहचान - के संबंध में।

As a trade facilitation measure and to assist officers in the verification and processing of imported hazardous cargo, changes have been made in the system to identify hazardous cargo at the time of filing the Bill of Entry.

2. The importer is required to mandatorily declare hazardous cargo at the item level in the Bill of entry, if the goods fall under the Chapters 28, 29 and 38. The importer or Customs Broker is required to declare the following details under Single Window table (BE_SW_INFO_TYPE table) in the format given below:

Info Type	Info qfr	Info code	Info text	Comments
CHR	HZRDS	Y/N (Y- Hazardous, N - Non-Hazardous)	Free text (Mandatory in case info code 'Y')	In case of 'Y' the importer has to declare the nature of hazardous goods etc. in info text.

3. The Hazardous cargo will be flagged by the system to the officer for faster clearance of such goods. During assessment, Examination and OOC for goods falling under chapter 28,29 and 38 an alert will be shown to the officer that

“This BE contains Hazardous goods... please check.”

Further, an alert will also be displayed to the examining officer through the alert option in ICETAB, in cases where hazardous cargo has been declared by the importer in the Single Window table. However, in cases where the info code is declared as 'N' by the importer, no alert will be populated to the officer.

4. Further, if the officer changes CTH during assessment of goods and the

new CTH falls under chapter 28,29 and 38, then the officer is required to mention Hazardous cargo details as explained in para 2 above.
